<b>Year One</b>
THEO 2721 or THEO 2735  UFDN 1000*
<b>Year Two</b>
THEO 2400  THEO 2620 or THEO 2710 or THEO 2730  UFDN 2000/3001 Christian Scriptures* (preferably Autumn Quarter)  UFDN 3100 (students intending to major in Christian Theology may take UFDN 3100 during Spring Quarter of their sophomore year—contact the instructor of the UFDN 3100 section for permission)
<b>Year Three</b>
THEO 3110 or THEO 3210  Focus Core: Christian Heritage (see Catalog major requirements for options)  Focus Core: Christian Scripture (see Catalog major requirements for options)  Focus Core: Christian Theology (see Catalog major requirements for options)  Focus Core: Christian Ministry (see Catalog major requirements for options)  Note: Sometime during their junior year, students should speak with their faculty advisor to begin planning for the Internship in Year Four (including identifying a faculty member to supervise the Internship—in most cases, this will not be the faculty advisor).
<b>Year Four</b>
Focus Electives (any additional 17 THEO credits, selected in consultation with the faculty advisor)  THEO 4899  THEO 4940

\*Students admitted to SPU with junior or senior standing do not take UFDN 1000. They complete UFDN 3001 Christian Scriptures instead of UFDN 2000 Christian Scriptures, followed by UFDN 3100.
